I. CALL TO ORDER: Bill Hamilton called the February 17, 2020 meeting of the Parks and Recreation Board to order. Bill Hamilton welcomed Marlin McKay to the Board.

II. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: A motion was made by Jaime Kumar to accept the minutes of the January 21, 2020 meeting, seconded by Ben Van Meter. The motion carried unanimously.

III. BOOKKEEPERS REPORT: Julie reported that the balance on hand is \$861,302.38. The balance on hand this date last year was \$1,169,089.24.

IV. BILLS FOR APPROVAL: Julie gave the Board a list of bills to be approved for payment. A motion was made by Erik Flaig to approve the bills, seconded by Ben Van Meter. The motion carried unanimously.

V. BUSINESS:

- A. Soccer Chris Calulot, President of Georgetown FC presented financial, participation and Phase I information on the soccer program. There have been \$16,000.00 donated in Sonya Ducett's name towards the new complex. The total cost of the complete project will probably be \$400,000.00 to \$500,000.00. A new adult league is being formed. Request for next year more trash cans, fencing, mole removal, a place to display their awards and to move their reporting to June.
- B. <u>Football</u> Adam Crace, President of SCYF presented financial and participation information. A new LED scoreboard was donated by Central Bank. Spring flag season begins April 18. The concession/storage building expansion is waiting on Architect drawing before work can begin.
- C. <u>Cell Phone Discussion</u> Tim Wait, First Net/AT&T presented plans. Wireless broadband for first responders. Band
 14. Tim will have to investigate if Parks would be eligible for this service.
- D. <u>Marketing Report</u> Kim Rice presented the 2019 4th quarter report. The annual report is almost completed. It will now be called the Georgetown Scott County Parks and Recreation impact report.

- E. <u>Athletic Field Contract</u> The contract is basically the same except with Great Crossing tennis courts and Great Crossing High School being added and the amount of insurance needed changed to one million. Cam will make these adjustments. Erik Flaig motioned to approve the contract subject to these changes, seconded by Ben Van Meter, DT Wells abstained, and the motion carried.
- F. Horse Park Contract Contract not available yet.
- G. Supersharks Contract The contract has been updated and includes a swim meet to be held at the Pavilion. DT Wells motioned to accept the contract, seconded by Andrea Giusti and the motion carried unanimously.
- H. <u>Board Policy Draft</u> The policy review committee presented a draft. Ben Van Meter motioned to accept the Board Policy Draft as presented subject to Cam Culbertson's final review as the Board Attorney, seconded by DT Wells and the motion carried unanimously.
- I. <u>Executive Session KRS61.810(1)(f)</u> Ben Van Meter motioned to go into Executive Session for the purpose of promotion or appointment of an employee to a position, seconded by Andrea Giusti and the motion carried unanimously. No action was taken in Executive Session. Ben Van Meter motioned that Lily Caudill be hired in as Aquatics Director at a salary of \$42,000.00 a year, seconded by Jaime Kumar and the motion carried unanimously.
- J. <u>Directors Report</u> Sherri Nicholas congratulated Lily Caudill. Sherri questioned the board about what retention schedule to follow due to the audit situation. Bill Hamilton led the discussion to agree to keep all documents for two years and then revisit the issue 2022. Sherri is currently working on the budget and will have the information at March meeting. The city and county is going to pay for the playground fence which will be installed after the pour and play surface is complete. The SFAC repair will need to be bid unless the price for repair can be negotiated.
- K. <u>Facilities/Program Report</u>- Robin Allen reported the Pavilion program January attendance 3,516. The total Pavilion attendance 15,138. Ed Davis Learning Center January total attendance 48. Robin is retiring February 28th after 32 years.
- Maintenance Reports Larry Brandenburg/Parks Gearing up for spring, Bill Parker/Facility Report SFAC repairs ongoing.

<u>VI. ADJOURNMENT:</u> There being no further business to be brought to the Parks and Recreation Board, a motion was made by Ben Van Meter to adjourn, seconded by Andrea Giusti, meeting adjourned.

Proposed Budget FY 2020—2021

Dear Judge Covington and Fiscal Court,

It is my pleasure to present to Judge Covington and the Fiscal Court the proposed Fiscal Year 2020-2021 General and Capital Budgets for the Georgetown – Scott County Parks and Recreation Department. This budget protects and furthers the progress of the city of Georgetown, Scott County, and the Parks and Recreation Department. It keeps the focus on core community services as well as looking to the future with the county's continued growth in mind.

The following pages list the goals and objectives the department has set for the 2020-2021 fiscal year. I would like to focus on two of those goals in this letter and leave the rest for you to read at your leisure. Hopefully, you will have questions that will spark a discussion that leads us to ever changing plans and goals for our department and for our community.

The first goal I want to focus on is Goal 1: To systematically and efficiently provide for the park and recreational needs of all Georgetown and Scott County residents by use of both public and private resources. The objectives listed explain how the department intends to accomplish this goal in general terms, but I would like to mention two specific examples. Over the past year the department has worked diligently to seek out new funding sources for projects and new ideas. Our 501(c)(3) organization, through departmental support, has worked diligently to raise funds which have made a significant impact on our parks resources that are not reflected in our budget. GSC Friends of the Parks has provided almost \$7,000 to assist with a fence for the inclusive playground adjacent to the Pavilion. In addition, GSC Friends of the Parks has raised over \$16,000 which is designated to the Lisle Road Soccer Complex / Legacy Trail project. We will also continue to support the County through grant applications to lower the cost to taxpayers of the development of Lisle Road Soccer Complex / Legacy Trail Project. Private support of our programs and special events will continued to be pursued for such events at "Movies in the Park".

The second goal I want to discuss is Goal 3: To provide facilities for both passive and active recreation to meet the needs of all Georgetown/Scott County residents. As the community continues to grow we must always remember it is our duty to maintain the facilities that we have and to continually seek opportunities for future development. The department has beautiful facilities, but we must never settle and believe what we have is enough. We will continue to work with Scott County Fiscal Court through the process of redeveloping Lisle Road Soccer Complex to bring the needed amenities to our Georgetown Football Club with a duel benefit of beginning the development of the Legacy Trail into Scott County.

I would like to thank Judge Covington and the Fiscal Court for their continued financial support of the Georgetown – Scott County Parks and Recreation Department. This support enables the department to provide the crucial services that our community members expect and deserve. As I state every year, the department's mission statement and vision statement are more than just words on a page. They are the motivation for the decisions we make and the services we provide.

I look forward to discussing the proposed FY 2020-2021 budget with you. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.

Offer a comprehensive program of recreation and park activities with the opportunity for a variety of experiences that meet the physical and psychological needs of the residents of Georgetown/Scott County.

- 1. To identify the demand for and types of programs needed and desired to ensure a wide variety of opportunities for people of all ages, abilities, and interests.
- 2. To interact with private, public, and other organizations to facilitate services and eliminate wasteful duplication.

- 3. To enhance public knowledge and appreciation for the natural beauty of open space, green space, and the environmental significance of our surroundings.
- 4. To plan and maintain programs and services of the highest standards.
- 5. Improve process for evaluating programs and services for operational efficiency and effectiveness.
- 6. Enhance health and wellness of our patrons through innovative and diversified recreation, leisure, and park programs.

Goal 3: Recreation Facilities

To provide facilities for both passive and active recreation to meet the needs of all Georgetown/ Scott County residents.

- The Georgetown Scott County Parks and Recreation Department includes community parks, neighborhood parks, and other facilities that provide for the recreational needs of the community. It is the department's intent to continue to maintain, develop, and add additional facilities of this nature to keep up with the growth and demand of the community.
- 2. To identify the public's wants and needs for both active and passive recreation through surveys, comment cards, public meetings, etc.
- 3. To take inventory of current facilities and evaluate the adequacy of such.
- 4. To make all facilities available to all community residents.
- 5. To make all facilities accessible to all community residents.
- 6. To provide areas for both organized and spontaneous play.
- 7. Enhance health and wellness of our patrons through innovative and diversified recreation, leisure, and park facilities.
- 8. Continually strive to improve existing facilities while seeking opportunities for future development.

Goal 4: Open Space and Environmental Conservation

To create open space areas that preserve and protect areas of important environmental consideration, and to incorporate such areas into the parks and recreation system.

- 1. To identify key areas of environmental/ecological importance such as wetlands, flood plains, and areas of natural scenic beauty with the intent to protect such areas within the parks and recreation system.
- 2. To reclaim areas of environmental/ecological deterioration using available resources from public and private sectors.
- 3. To protect and preserve open space areas for recreational use by the community.
- 4. Advance natural resources educational and interpretation.
- 5. Integrate environmentally sound practices into park management of natural resources.

Goal 5: Maintenance

To maintain safe and reliable facilities in an efficient and effective manner.

1. To provide a system of safety inspections and maintenance of all equipment and facilities. Inspections and maintenance will be provided on a frequent regular basis.

- 2. To provide the maximum level of safety at all levels in the department for both participants and employees.
- 3. Determine life cycles for equipment and schedule maintenance and replacement or renovation funding.

Goal 6: Marketing and Citizen Recognition and Participation

Diving Blocks: Diving Blocks at the Pavilion are compromised with excessive rust and fault lines which will progress into failure.

Seeder: Seeder will replace a 1991 slit seeder

Replacement of overhang decks at Royal Spring Park: Both overhang decks at Royal Spring Park are in desperate need of replacement.

TRX Freestanding Machine for Freeweight Room: We are committed to replacing a minimum of one piece of equipment in the Pavilion Freeweight Room as part of our preventive maintenance programs.

Treadmills for the Cardio Room (3): We are committed to replacing a minimum of one piece of equipment in the Pavilion Cardio Room as part of our preventive maintenance program. Currently there are 3 treadmills which have over 30,000 and are approaching their life expectancy.

Zero Turn Mowers (2): New mowers will replace two (2004/2005) John Deer 777. Each mower has excessive repairs needed including a blown mower and hydraulic pumps.

Ford F250 (Parks): This truck will replace a 2004 Ford 150 which is used for spreading salt which has caused damage due to rust. Current Mileage is 130,776.

Light Fixtures at Scott County and Brooking Park playground and parking lot areas: There are multiple lights that are out in both parks which are a safety hazard.

Utility Gator: Will replace a 2003 Gator Utility Vehicle which is used on a daily basis and is requiring many repairs.

Backstop / Foul Poles / Fencing on Fields 2 and 3 at Suffoletta Memorial Park: Fencing on noted fields is curling, damaged, and is a safety hazard.

Bobcat skid loader: The skid loader will replace at 1994 bobcat which has over 2,000 hours and weak hydraulics.

Replace Spray Insulation at Maintenance Shop: The Parks Maintenance shop at Scott County Park is 20 years old. The current insulation is falling down.

Infield Material for Marshal Park fields 1, 2, 3, & 4: Due to constant use of softball teams, the infield material at Marshall park needs to be replaced to provide proper playing fields.
